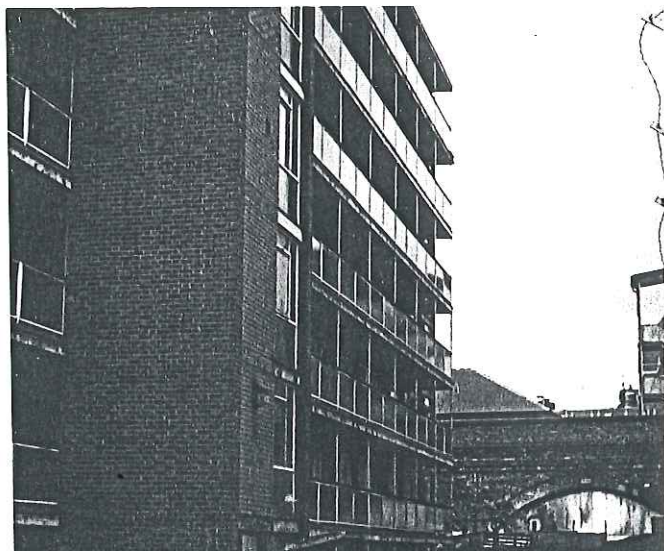

With the support of the Tenants Advisor, a group of committed residents have formed a Tenants Association on your estate. The council will be able to give them training and to provide money to support them. It is an organisation where your views can be represented to the council through the Tenants Association committee

What is the Canalside Housing Partnership?

The Canalside Housing Partnership is two Housing Associations - Metropolitan Housing Trust and Community Housing Association - working together to regenerate your estate. We were selected by tenants and Hackney Council to develop proposals with you to improve your estate.

Every secure tenant and leaseholder will be given the opportunity to vote later this year on the proposals to transfer to the Canalside Housing Partnership. Before the vote takes place, you will be given a detailed proposal setting out the works proposed, your rights on transfer and the rents and charges you will pay.
